Audition requirements for Chamber Music Camp: Major & Minor Scales: 2 or 3 octaves up to 3 sharps and 3 flats with accurate intonation

Prepared solo: Student's choice, two minutes long (the equivalent of Suzuki Book 2 level or above)

There will also be a short theory assessment at the audition.

Because a limited number of quartets will be accepted, early registration is advised.

A placement audition will be required.
